- 4. Brauerei Zwanzger** (Uehlfeld): A family brewery in Uehlfeld since 1696, featuring a traditional brewery.
- 5. Brauerei Prechel** (Uehlfeld): Another family brewery in Uehlfeld, known for its Hausbrau.
